

Uniform Dress Code Guidelines

Basic School Uniform	Clarification
<p><u>Tops and Sweaters</u> Collared shirts and blouses must be totally SOLID in color (Navy Blue, Forest Green, or White).</p> <p>Shirts or blouses must have buttons to the neckline; top button may be undone.</p> <p>Undershirt must be white.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sweaters or sweatshirts that are striped, patterned, or multicolored are not permitted. • See-through or lace sweaters and shirts are not permitted. • No Hoodies (a “tucked-in” hoodie is still a hoodie) • Student’s initials (personal monograms) on shirts, sweaters, or sweatshirts are not permitted. PFMS machine embroidered logos or PFMS monograms are allowed. • Shirrtails will be tucked in at all times. All shirts must be long enough to tuck in and stay.
<p><u>Bottoms</u> All bottoms must be uniform-color bottoms: Navy Blue or Khaki.</p> <p>Skirts, shorts, jumpers, and skorts must be no more than two inches above the knee.</p> <p>Bottoms will be worn at the waist line.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Items NOT permitted are jeans, logos, leggings, jeggings (leggings as pants), stretch/spandex material pants, cargo-style pants, “jogger” pants, elastic cuffs, overalls, or any other variation to the dress code even if they are khaki or navy. • No hip huggers, “skinny” style, low rise, or “sagging” of pants permitted. • Skirts, shorts, and jumpers will be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee. • Boot cut or flare pants must allow the toe of the shoes to be clearly visible. • Gym shorts are not permitted under uniform bottoms.
<p><u>Shoes</u> Shoes must be SOLID in color White or Black. Soles, logos, and trimming must be the same color as the shoe.</p> <p><u>Socks</u> Socks or Nylons must be worn at all times. Socks must be SOLID White or Black and both socks must match and be the same color. Nylons (hose) must be SOLID Navy Blue, White, or Flesh Tone.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No open-toed or open-heeled shoes. Shoes must cover both the toe and the heel (i.e. no clogs or sandals) but not enclose the ankle (i.e. no boots, mid tops, or high tops). • Heels should be no higher than 2 inches from where the leather meets the sole at the heel of the shoe to the floor. • No designs on socks are permitted.
<p><u>Belts</u> Belts must be worn at all times if pants have belt loops.</p> <p>Belts must be solid Black.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Belts will be worn with slacks, shorts, and skirts that have belt loops. Large buckles, studs, and metal rings are not permitted. No imprinted designs or embellishments are allowed. • The entire belt must be tucked into the belt loops. Plain belt buckles are to be no larger than 2”x 2”. • Blouses or shirrtails will be tucked in at all time with belt or waistband visible.
<p><u>Outerwear</u> Blazers, cardigan sweaters, and lightweight jackets may be worn. They must be a SOLID Navy Blue, Black or White (NO LINES DOWN THE SLEEVES)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Outerwear worn throughout the day must not have hoods nor tied around the waist. • Heavier coats may be worn to school, but must be placed in the locker upon arrival and must remain there until the last scheduled trip to the locker.
<p><u>Additional Guidelines:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ All attire will be neat, clean, and in good repair. ▪ Hats or sunglasses will not be worn for any reason during the school day. ▪ Hair will be neatly groomed. No unnatural hair colors are permitted (green, purple, blue, red (crimson, intensive, etc.). No Mohawks or scalp designs. No headgear, visors, sweatbands, doo-rags, bandanas or scarves. Hair accessories for girls must be black, white, or navy and may not be distracting. Boys are not allowed to wear hair accessories. ▪ Excessive makeup and distracting jewelry may not be worn. ▪ Earrings for girls should not be more than quarter size. Colors must be gold or silver. ▪ Multiple bracelets and wristbands are not permitted ▪ No facial or tongue piercings allowed. ▪ No tattoos. ▪ Purses/handbags may not exceed 8 x 8 x 3 inches in size. Backpack style purses, solid drawstring bags and fanny packs are not allowed. Gym clothes can be carried in grocery, mesh or clear drawstring bags before and after scheduled PE class. <p>STUDENTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO DRESS IN A MANNER WHICH DISRUPTS OR DISTRACTS OTHERS FROM LEARNING, IS OFFENSIVE TO OTHERS, OR VIOLATES HEALTH OR SAFETY REQUIREMENTS.</p> <p>ADMINISTRATION WILL MAKE THE FINAL DECISION ON ALL DRESS CODE RELATED INFRACTIONS.</p>
